

## \* STATE QUALIFYING PARAMETERS & REGISTRATION GUIDELINES \*

This season, top finishing teams in all HoopSource Youth Tournaments will qualify for one of three (3) State Tournaments held this Winter:

- (1) Oregon Middle School State Championships (Bend/Redmond) "SCHOOL BASED ONLY: 5<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> Grade"
- (2) Washington Middle School State Championships (Spokane) "OPEN CLUB/SCHOOL: 4<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> Grade"
- (3) Arizona Middle School State Championships (Tucson) "OPEN CLUB/SCHOOL: 4<sup>th</sup> 8<sup>th</sup> Grade"

## Teams competing in HoopSource Events will qualify based on the following results:

- (D1 Elite Level) Divisions: All 1st & 2nd place finishing teams in any HoopSource Event
- (D2 Competitive Level) Divisions: All 1st & 2nd place finishing teams in any HoopSource Event
- (D3 Developmental Level) Divisions: All 1st & 2nd place finishing teams in any HoopSource Event

## **General Registration Guidelines for "School-Based Feeder" Teams:**

- \* Most school based "feeder" (A Level) teams play at the D2 Level.
- \* Most school based "feeder" (B Level) teams play at the D3 Level.
- \* Our (D1 Level) is "Open" to anyone & consists of the highest level teams in the region.

If you "qualify" at a HoopSource Event, you will be eligible to compete in your respective State Championship Event (Contact Information -
